Rehabilitation of the sewer collection system is a comprehensive physical process that begins with cleaning and inspection of sewer pipes and manholes. Typical rehabilitation repairs include pipe and manhole replacement and trenchless technologies that minimize above ground disturbances, such as cured-in-place pipe liners.



One of the first steps in rehabilitation includes a physical inspection of manholes and pipes to identify blockages.

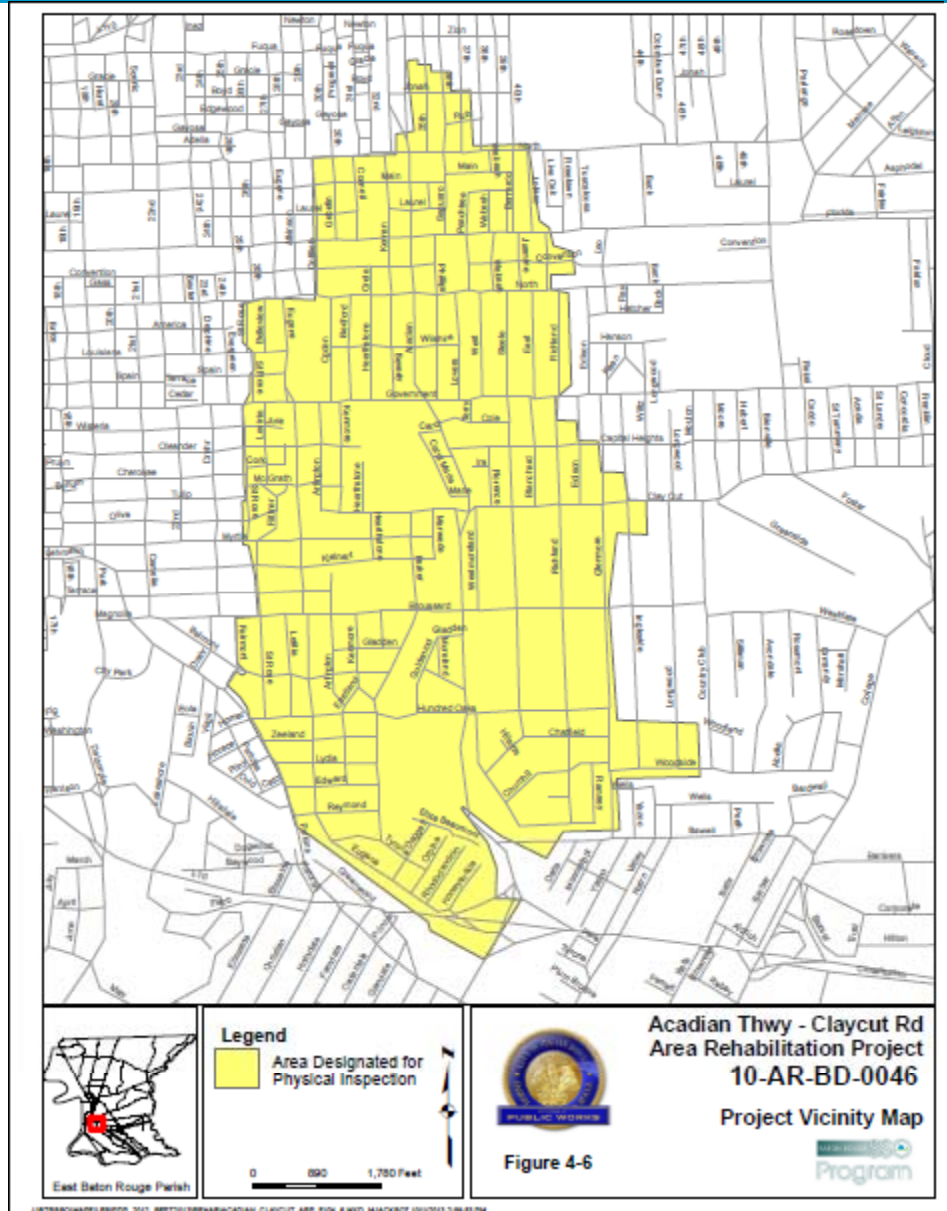


Before

- Approximately 184,035 linear feet of pipeline will be inspected and rehabilitated
- Approximately 712 manholes will be rehabilitation or replaced
