This project includes improvements that were previously included in SGU-C-0001 (Multiple Pump Stations-Florida Blvd – Sherwood Forest Blvd) and SGC-C-0001 (Airline Highway - Florida Blvd PS30 Improvements and new pump station). This combined project includes upgrades to eight pump stations and the construction of a new pump station to alleviate SSOs in the upstream basins.





Pump Station #50, located at the intersection of Major Oaks Road and Sherwood Forest Blvd, will be upgraded.



Pump Station #30, located on Tom Drive near the intersection of Dallas Drive, will be upgraded.



A new pump station will be installed North of Tara Boulevard and Old Hammond Highway.
